No meeting was called to order or business conducted on April 8 & 9, 2016 Clean Sweep events at the Jefferson County Fair Park, 503 N. Jackson Avenue, Jefferson, WI 53549

1. Clean Sweep Event Operation

A. Place: Jefferson County Fair Park, 503 N. Jackson Avenue, Jefferson, WI

Directions: Facility located at the Jefferson County Fair Park, 3 ½ blocks north of W. Racine Street (US Highway 18) on N. Jackson Avenue and 4 ½ blocks west of Main Street (State Road 26) on W. Puerner Street.

B. Time: The staff, Solid Waste/Air Quality Committee and volunteers arrival times:
1:30 p.m. on Friday, April 8, 2016
7:30 a.m. on Saturday, April 9, 2016
All volunteers need to sign in.

C. Tires: We collected tires on both days. The location for the tire disposal was at the Cleary Building by Gate 3. 26 resident brought 367 tires (4.07 ton). The total fee we collected for disposal from residents was \$902. Liberty Tire Recycling invoiced us \$803.42.

D. Safety Meeting:

Veolia Project Manager Chris Bahlow conducted a safety meeting for all Committee members, staff, and volunteers on Friday at 1:30 p.m. and on Saturday at 7:30 a.m. He explained the safety procedures that need to be followed at a Clean Sweep event. After he was done, Sharon explained the jobs to the volunteers and Committee members; jobs then were assigned.

E. Dress Requirements:

Dress Requirements are no sandals, open toed shoes or shorts. Dress appropriately for weather conditions.

Everything was in place at least 15 minutes before starting time each day and we immediately started putting cars through the event. At this time we already had two businesses in line.

The results of our Clean Sweep event:

181 Jefferson County Clean Sweep Participants which included:
129 households, 19 farms, 5 businesses, 3 county facilities and 25 that were not surveyed.
26 residents participated in the tire recycling.

We had taken 160 appointments before the event. We had 21 drive ups.

We received \$10 in donations.

The cost of the Household Waste was \$19,844.09, Pharmaceutical Waste \$199.65 (mostly inhalers), County Facilities \$870.12, Ag Waste \$2,366.20 for a total of \$23,280.06

The Highway Department paid \$1,174.75 for their own waste disposal and the 5 businesses paid \$2,690.95 for a total \$3,865.70.

The total pounds of Household Waste was 15,360#, Ag Waste was 1,541# and VSQG waste was 6,420.75# for a total of 23,321.75 pounds
