Specific Objectives for Operational Period 1 Assess magnitude and area of flooding impact 2 Determine time frame to initial inundation 3 Identify potential high risk impact areas, populations, infrastructure, key resources 4 Determine available protective actions - expedient flood protection, evacuation, move items to high platforms/locations, shelter needs 5 Evaluate resource availability - sand, sand bags, sheet poly, labor, transportation, (Look to ICS 204 for additional details) 6 Determine impact to critical infrastructure/key resources 7 Determine need to pre-position resources, develop and implement resource positioning plan, including extended staffing patterns 8 Establish an Incident Command System structure 9 Conduct briefings with required supporting agencies including liaisons to Health and Human Service agencies, utilities, hospitals, and other key resources/infrastructure, activate Emergency Operations Center and required supporting agencies as needed 10 Prepare and distribute an ICS 201 or ICS 209 prior to each operational period to establish and maintain situational awareness 11 Chief Elected Official (or designee) issue statement of emergency 12 Implement personnel and equipment accountability system/process 13 Activate public information plan for flooding and other anticipated emergencies, establish recommendations for facility closings, Reunification Center(s), Family Assistance Centers, Disaster Assistance Center(s) 14 Develop response priorities and assign available resources 15 Activate mutual aid agreements as warranted 16 Develop and implement debris management plan 17 Develop and implement shelter operations plans, including functional needs as needed 18 Develop Search and Rescue operation plan 19 Develop and ensure implementation of a welfare inquiry plan 20 Develop and implement safe evacuation routes 21 Establish and secure affected areas 22 Develop, coordinate and implement traffic plan 23 Conduct rapid needs assessment 24 Conduct damage assessment 25 Submit Uniform Disaster Situation Report to WEM 26 Develop demobilization plans
