1. Call to Order

After he was done, Sharon explained the jobs to the volunteers and Committee members. Sharon then assigned the various Clean Sweep jobs.

At 7:45 everything was in place and we started putting cars though the Clean Sweep. At this time we already had three cars in line.

The results of our Clean Sweep event:

71 Participants: 54 household, 13 farms, and 4 VSQG businesses

77 Appointments: 9 No shows/cancels and 3 drive-in without appointment

The cost of the April 14, 2012 Fair Park Clean Sweep is as follows:

Four survey questions were asked with these results:

1. Have you used this service before? 33 Yes and 38 No
2. Did you bring chemicals, drugs, or drugs only? 44 chemicals, 3 drugs only & 24 both
3. Do you know about the three electronic recycling sites? 43 Yes and 28 No
4. Do you know about the three drug collection sites? 42 Yes and 29 No

We had 13 residents from the City of Jefferson, 11 residents from City of Fort Atkinson and 47 residents from all other areas of Jefferson County.
