



More specifically, the memorial would be located in a designated area in the parking lot. The location would be in the area typically referred to as the "upper lot", or shared parking lot between the Sheriff's Office and Courthouse. There are 2 areas along the east wall in this lot that now only contain shrubs. The proposed area would be the southern of the 2 areas, depicted in these pictures:
