

Concrete Lined – Manure Storage Basin Evaluation

Mark,

On behalf of Hoard's Dairyman Farm, we would like to submit our completed evaluation of the concrete lined manure storage basin at the farm site in Ft. Atkinson. Along with this evaluation, we have also included our recommendations for a repair work plan to address surface shrinkage cracking found during our site survey activities.

Based on data and/or information gathered during the past 6 months, Hoard's Dairyman Farm has elected to move forward with our recommended repair work plan. Upon review and approval of your office, we would anticipate starting this work the first week in June, 2015. Depending on weather conditions, the entire work plan is scheduled to be completed in two weeks. We would expect the manure storage basin, at the Hoard's Dairy Farm site, to be placed back in service by the end of June, 2015.

Enclosed you should find all the repair locations and technical specifications that will be followed in the completion of this work plan. REA will be on-site during this period. We will issue a quality assurance certification to the owner/operator following completion of the repair work and prior to placing this storage basin into service.


