### Summary Highlights:

The 2016 budget provides \$236,468 in the tax levy, which is a \$5,354 increase in levy from the 2015 amended budget.

In 2015, the Farmland Preservation program was moved from the County Board budget to the Land Conservation budget.

# WISCONSIN DEER DONATION 2015

Funded by Wisconsin's Wildlife Damage Program and Hunter Donations

HUNTERS, you can help feed needy people throughout Wisconsin this fall by taking four simple steps:

- **Donate any legally harvested deer by dropping it off at a participating processor by January 31, 2016. All adult deer harvested in the following counties are required to be tested for CWD: Adams, Grant, Green, Jefferson, Juneau, Kenosha, Lafayette, Portage, Racine, and Waukesha.**
- **All adult deer and fawns harvested from the following counties are required to be tested for CWD: Columbia, Dane, Iowa, Richland, Rock, Sauk, and Walworth.**
- **Prior to donating the deer field dress and register it and write your confirmation number on the carcass tag. Handle the carcass as if it was destined for your own table. Donate the entire deer to receive the processing costs for free (head & antlers may be kept for mounting).**
- **Call First! Contact one of the participating processors before dropping the deer off to verify the processor has space to accept your deer. Some counties with metro deer management units may be accepting deer until the end of the metro hunts. Check locally with your processor.**



# Jefferson County Land and Water Conservation Department 2015/2016 Tree and Shrub Sale Order Form



There are a limited number of trees and shrubs available. Trees will be reserved with paid and completed order forms on the date in which they are received. Place your order early!

Minimum order of any one species is 25 trees. All orders must be in multiples of 25.

We are required to collect 5.5% sales tax on all trees sold. **If you are tax exempt, please include your signed tax exemption form with your order.**

Pick up will be mid to late spring at the Jefferson County Fair Grounds. Post cards will be sent out to notify customers of pick up dates and times. For more information on the trees and shrubs, visit our website [www.jeffersoncountywi.gov](http://www.jeffersoncountywi.gov)

**Fraser Fir 12 - 16" \$30** ~ Often referred to as the Cadillac of Christmas trees. Has an excellent fragrance and exceptional needle retention. Likes cool, moist, well drained soil. Full to partial sun. Will not do well in heavy, wet clay soil.

**Red Pine 7 - 15" \$30** ~ Grows over 35'. Rapid growing tree with long, glossy-green needles. Has many uses: timber, windbreak, ornamental, and Christmas tree. Does well in sandy soil.

**White Pine 7 - 15" \$30** ~ Grows over 35'. Vigorous growing, open tree with long, soft, bluish-green needles. Used in ornamental plantings. Tolerates shade and grows well in sandy and other soils.

**Blue Spruce 12 - 16" \$30** ~ Grows over 35'. Densely formed tree with stiff silvery-blue to bluish-green needles. An excellent ornamental and background tree. Thrives in dry, well-drained soil.

**Eastern Arborvitae (White Cedar) 12 - 16" \$30** ~ Height of 30-40', width 10-15'. Fan-like glossy leaves provide year-round color. Forms a wind tight barrier when used for screening or as hedging. Prefers heavy damp areas, but adapts well to other soil types.

**Dogwood-Silky 12 - 24" (2 Yr Seedling) \$30** ~ A native shrub. Grows 6 - 8' high with its leaves silky to the touch beneath. Flowers are white, fruit blue. Hardy everywhere.

**Hazelnut 12 - 18" (2 Yr Seedling) \$30** ~ Small shrub often in clumps reaching 12' in height. Edible brown nuts. Grows best in moist, well-drained soils but will adapt to most types of soils. Full sun or partial shade. Attracts wildlife such as deer, grouse, turkeys, pheasants, and quail.

**Burr Oak 12 - 18" (1 Yr Seedling) \$30** ~ Tolerates a variety of soil conditions. Prefers full sun, offers dense shade, acorns are a food source for wood ducks, wild turkeys and white tailed deer. Leaf color is dark green in summer and yellow to yellowish-brown in fall. Height 70 - 80'.

**Serviceberry-Juneberry 12 - 18" (1 Yr Seedling) \$30** ~ Grows 3 - 18'. Adaptable to most soil types with exception of poorly drained or heavy clay soils lacking organic matter. Small to medium suckering shrub that bears white flowers followed by edible fruit in June-July.
