Keep medicines in original containers. Cross out your name and prescription number. Do not remove the name of the drug because we need that information for proper sorting. There is no limit to the amount of drugs that can be brought and no questions will be asked of whoever brings them. All drugs are properly disposed of through the Jefferson County Clean Sweep Program.

Businesses: Charged based on weight-Registration required three weeks prior to collection event
